

Special Selectboard Meeting

Monday, August 7, 2017

Doon called the meeting to order at 6:00 am.

Discussion ensued of possible road projects for the Municipal Road Grant-in-Aid Pilot Project which concerns water quality on road runoff. The amount of this grant is approximately \$18,000. The state is trying to ensure that material stays out of the rivers. The map forwarded by TRORC shows the segments of roads in Rochester that are potential problem areas where concerns are where river water is within 500 feet from the road. Campbell Rd is in bad condition, and Marsh Brook Road up from the bridge is as well. Dan noted that Town Line Road needs ditching and edges pulled. Saw Mill Hill Rd needs gravel. The board agreed that it makes more sense to rent an excavator and focus on upgrading Town Line Road with the Grant-in-Aid funds. Doon will check with Joan about the status of the Class 2 grant.
