Approve North Star Rubbish Removal, LLC contract 7/01/2023-6/30/2024.: Doon moved to approve the new contract with North Star Rubbish. Frank seconded. All in favor. So, approved.

Adopt 2023 LEMP-(signature required from someone with ICS100 Certification): Doon tabled this waiting for Larry Plesent to finish his certification training classes. He is nearly finished.

Changing speed limit on Bethel Mountain Road Ordinance: Doon shared this is the beginning process to change the speed limit on a portion of Bethel Mountain Road. The board will adopt under 24 V.S.A sections 1971-1976. It will promote public safety to match Bethel's side of the mountain speed limit of 40 mph. The process is to warn for 30 days and take public comments before adopting. The location of the speed change is on Bethel Mountain from Middle Hollow Road to the Bethel Town line. The notice will be submitted to the paper and posted around town for 30 days and a public comment will follow. A road study was completed last year.

Approve Huntington House First Class Hotel License: Doon moved to approve. Frank seconded. All in favor. So, approved.

Approve Huntington House Outside Consumption Permit: Doon moved to approve. Frank seconded. All in favor. So, approved.

Last of the Appointments - Tri-Valley Transit Rep and Budget and Finance Member: Doon appointed Tim Crowley as the Tri-Valley Transit Rep and Robert Meagher as a board member to the Budget and Finance Committee. This completes all the appointments for 2024.
